- National Pearl Harbor Remembrance Day, also referred to as Pearl Harbor Day, is
 observed annually in the United States on December 7, to remember and honor the 2,403
 Americans who were killed in the Japanese surprise attack on Pearl Harbor in Hawaii on
 December 7, 1941, which led to United States declaring war on Japan the next day and thus
 entering World War II.
 - In 1994, the United States Congress designated DEcember 7th of each year as National Pearl Harbor Remembrance Day. On Pearl Harbor Day, the American flag is flown at half-staff until sunset to honor those who died as a result of the attack on U.S. military forces in Hawaii.
 - Today we dedicate our moment of silence to those we lost in this attack and those who bravely fought on behalf of the UNited States in World War II.
